PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Last week I sent out a discernment letter to staff asking them to share their intentions for the 2017-18 school year. They are due back Friday, March 10th.
- I am currently doing the yearly required formal observations of teachers teaching religion; if they are a specialist it will be in their subject area.
- School climate – put our work with Marsha into a template, it needs to be reviewed my teachers and needs a little more work.
- We are seeking a head cook for next year as well as food service workers, am concerned with finding food service workers due to low wages.
- Concerned with low pay for educational assistants.
- Continuing work on e-rate.
- Have been working with John Jurichko from ATSR via email for kitchen upgrade plan.
- Planning to work with Mohs Construction on the kitchen project. Will need to figure out where the money will come from.
- Teachers are continuing to work on Ace Curriculum through the diocese.
- The teachers will have a speaker this coming Wed., March 1st on multi-age teaching. The speaker will be Mrs. Mindy Reeder from Nativity in Bloomington. She did multi-age when she was Principal in Montgomery.
- Mr. Smith will also do a presentation for the school advisory during our meeting on Tuesday evening, Feb. 28th.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- **Facilities and Long Range Planning Committee**
 - Repairs recently made, some sidewalk repaired, fuse replaced, PA system repaired
 - Kitchen planning continues and are receiving bid specs to complete
 - Presented several ideas to the Auction Committee for the Spirit of the Knight give
 - Gym curtains, Stage rigging and lighting, boost room, kitchen project
- **Finance**
 - Enrollment has stayed the same from last month
 - Our current year budget the Advisory Board approved a \$32,000 deficit, and at this point we are on track to have a deficit of \$56,000, looking at options to trim
 - Enrollment for next year is ahead of pace of last year with currently 179 enrolled in K-8. Currently have 294 and budgeting for 284.
 - SAC rates have been reviewed and will remain the same for next year.
 - Have a potential bequest that could cover kitchen project
 - Collecting information on staff requests and will have that information finalized in March so the Advisory Board can make a recommendation and also give staff an opportunity to review.
- **CEMF**
 - Will have a Visioning Session on March 16th
 - Stephen Nelson's son who is a lawyer that represents non-profits will attend to provide advice
- **Enrollment Management**
 - School open house and kindergarten round-up are complete, hand written thank you's are going out to all of the new families that attended
 - A testimonial letter written by Kim Kubicek has been sent to all parents with children in pre-K
 - Will have 2 parents attend the March Ministerium meeting with Fr. Sauer to promote St. Mary's in Owatonna
 - Continue to work with new families to enroll students online.
